
Occupations by Sector



















International Trade is Critical for U.S. Agriculture

- U.S. ag exports reached \$191 billion in 2023
- 20 percent of U.S. agricultural production is exported
- Ag exports supported approximately
 1.2 million jobs on and off the farm
- 95% of the world's population lives outside the United States












Trade Policy Examples

DATA AND ANALYSIS




- FAS works with international groups to produce market intelligence
- Provides objective data on foreign market conditions

Prepares production forecasts and assesses export opportunities

Tracks changes in policies affecting U.S. agricultural exports and imports









- FAS partners with 80 cooperator groups in the U.S. food and agricultural industry
- Manages market development programs
- Administers credit guarantee programs and other types of assistance
- Plans trade shows and missions

- FAS's non-emergency food aid programs help meet recipients' nutritional needs and supports agricultural development and education






Challenges of the Foreign Service Life

- Away from family and support networks (aging parents, etc.)


























What Does FDA Do?

- FDA regulates the safety of food, cosmetics, devices that emit radiation, and tobacco products.














